

Which is better, AKG (AKGEC) or ABES?: Comparative Analysis

Both g Engineering College (AKGEC, commonly known as AKG) and ABES Engineering College are well-known private engineering institutions under AKTU in Ghaziabad. AKGEC generally holds stronger institutional accreditations, a higher reputation in academic circles, and comparatively lower BTech fees. ABES, on the other hand, stands out for its placement volume and its exceptionally high top package, especially in the CSE branch.

When it comes to average packages, both colleges perform at a similar level, though ABES often records higher averages specifically for CSE. AKGEC maintains consistent placement trends across branches along with solid campus infrastructure and academic quality. ABES shows strength in recruiter participation, student development programs, and high-impact placement opportunities.

In simple terms: choose **ABES** if your priority is top-tier CSE placements and larger recruiter turnout. Choose **AKGEC** if you want stronger accreditations, stable placements across branches, and lower overall fees. Both colleges are strong options, and the better choice ultimately depends on whether you value cost-effectiveness or placement peaks.

- ABES: NAAC A grade, NBA accreditations, active placement cell with large recruiter pool; solid campus facilities and industry labs. ABES also highlights placement numbers prominently on its site.

Interpretation: On institutional credentials, **AKGEC slightly edges ABES** because of the A++ mention and multiple NBA accreditations; both are well-accredited but AKGEC's recent NAAC cycle and NBA coverage are strong selling points.

6) ROI (Fees vs Placements) — simple model

Assumptions (example):

- Full 4-yr tuition (no hostel): AKGEC ≈ ₹5.6–5.8 L (estimate based on ₹1.42 L first year + subsequent years); ABES ≈ ₹6.6–6.8 L (starting from ₹1.70 L first year). (Use official fee circulars to refine final totals.)

7) Pros & Cons — quick checklist

AKGEC — Pros

- Lower official first-year & likely total tuition (cheaper overall).
- Strong NAAC A++ and multiple NBA accreditations signals institutional quality.
- Consistent placement record and structured PDP programs.

AKGEC — Cons

Slightly lower top single offers vs ABES (top ≈₹55 LPA vs ABES ≈₹59.9 LPA).

ABES — Pros

- Very high top package (₹59.91 LPA) helps brand & aspirational hires.
- Large recruiter base and high placement volume; strong CSE outcomes.

ABES — Cons

Higher published first-year fee vs AKGEC — raise in total cost may affect some ROI calculations.

8) Who should pick which — recommendation grid

- If you want the best chance at ultra-high offers (product companies / unicorns) and you'll focus on CSE: ABES (strong CSE hiring, high top package).
- If you want lower total fees, strong institutional accreditations (NAAC A++ / NBA), and steady placements across branches: AKGEC.
- If you're undecided (not CSE) and care about overall campus reputation + cost: lean AKGEC for value; choose ABES if campus placement volume and recruiter diversity matter more.
