Post Graduate Diploma In Management (PGDM)

The two-year full-time Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM), approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Government of India and recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to an MBA degree of an Indian University, is consistently among India's top management programmes.

Teaching & Learning at MDI Gurgaon

- The teaching methods include lectures, case studies, seminars, assignments, live projects, group discussions, business games, outbound based experiential learning activities, educational excursions, role plays, simulation exercises, structured and unstructured group work, and field visits.
- Widespread use of Information Technology (IT) in the learning processes.

Programme Structure

Core Courses

- Six terms of about three months each - three in each year of the programme.
- The core (compulsory) courses are covered in four terms, with the bulk covered in the first three terms and the electives in Term-IV, V & VI of the Second Year.

Summer Internship

- Compulsory eight-to-ten weeks long internship after term-III.

Specializations

- Second year students may take elective / optional courses to specialize in a maximum of two of the following functional areas:
- **Accounting & Finance | Operations Management | Marketing | Strategy | Information Management.**
- Specialization requires a minimum of 5 elective courses (15 credits) offered by that Area.
- Students can opt for 14 to 17 electives (42 to 51 credits).
- CGPA would be calculated using the 14 electives (42 credits) completed with best performance.

Student Exchange Programme

- A student can study for one term in a partner foreign institution in lieu of his/her study term at MDI Gurgaon.
- A number of international scholarships are available for these students.
- Details on the selection process & opportunities will be available after joining MDI Gurgaon.

Evaluation

- MDI Gurgaon follows a continuous evaluation system. A student earns a letter grade in each course with an associated grade point.
- The credit-weighted average of these grade points in the programme is the Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

Scholarships/Financial Assistance

- 100% Tuition fee waiver under TFW scheme of AICTE is available to the students from EWS Category as per provisions of the scheme.
- MDI Gurgaon offers a Merit cum Means Scholarship scheme for the meritorious students to pursue PGDM courses at MDI Gurgaon belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS).
- It is envisaged to provide a total number of 12 merit-cum-means scholarships (50% waiver of tuition fees) every year to the students pursuing two-year full time PGDM/PGDM-HRM/PGDM-IB and PGDM-Business Analytics at MDI Gurgaon.
- O.P. Jindal scholarship of INR 1,50,000/- as per the selection Criteria of OPJEMS.
- At the end of the second year, MDI Gurgaon awards eight merit scholarships of INR 40,000/- each to the top eight students.

International Scholarships

Several international scholarships are available for MDI Gurgaon students going on the exchange programme to select partner institutions, Eg. Sciences Po Lille, University of Maribor, NUCB Business School & Japan.





Post Graduate Diploma In Management - Human Resource Management (PGDM-HRM)

The **PGDM-HRM** programme offered at MDI Gurgaon is designed to mentor holistic business managers. The course is designed and reviewed by faculty and industry members continuously to ensure a rich academia-industry blend. The programme is approved by the All-India Council for Technical Education, Government of India and recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) as equivalent to an MBA degree awarded by an Indian University.

Programme Structure

- The programme is spread over six terms of three months each. The core courses are covered in the first four terms.
- Compulsory eight-to-ten weeks long internship after term 3.
- During terms 5 & 6, students can opt for six electives from OB & HRM area and can also enrich their elective basket by opting for maximum of two electives from other functional areas such as Marketing / Economics & Public Policy / Operations Management / Accounting & Finance / Information Management / Strategy & General Management.
- 20 percent of the course is taught by industry practitioners.
- The HR programme curriculum is aligned with the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM).



Learning Centric Pedagogy

Post Graduate Diploma In Management - International Business (PGDM-IB)

A dual degree programme offered by MDI Gurgaon in collaboration with emlyon business school, Lyon, France and ESCP Business School, France: Post Graduate Diploma in Management- International Business (PGDM-IB) from MDI Gurgaon and Master in Management (MIM) from emlyon business school or ESCP Business School

PGDM-IB-MIM: A Dual Degree Programme in India & Europe

The PGDM-IB-MIM is a prestigious dual degree programme jointly offered by **MDI Gurgaon in collaboration with emlyon business school, Lyon, France and ESCP Business School, France**. Delivered across India and Europe, this programme provides a unique blend of academic rigor and international exposure. Both partner institutions hold prominent positions in global rankings. According to the Financial Times European Business School Rankings 2024, emlyon business school is ranked 11th and ESCP Business School is ranked 5th.

Programme Structure

Initial Study at MDI Gurgaon: Students begin the programme with two terms—Term I and II at MDI Gurgaon (Semester 1 of the partner Institution), where the focus is on foundational coursework. This phase emphasizes core inputs across qualitative and quantitative disciplines, aiming to build strong analytical, integrative, and communication skills.

International Component: After completing the initial two terms, students proceed to one of the partner institutions (emlyon business school in Lyon, France or to one of the six ESCP Business school campus locations; Paris, Berlin, Madrid, Turin, Warsaw and London) for two semesters (Semester 2 & 3 of the partner institution) equivalent to Terms III, IV, and V of MDI Gurgaon. During this phase, the curriculum provides an in-depth international management perspective, including a mandatory industry internship, primarily based in Europe, to ensure hands-on experience in a global business environment.

Final Term at MDI Gurgaon: Upon completion of the international component, students return to MDI Gurgaon for Term VI (Semester 4 of the partner institution), during which they complete the remaining academic requirements.

Award of Degrees

Subject to the successful fulfillment of all academic requirements at both institutions, students are awarded:

- **The Post Graduate Diploma in Management – International Business (PGDM-IB)** from MDI Gurgaon, and
- **The Master in Management (MIM)** degree from either emlyon business school or ESCP Business School, depending on the institution attended during their international component.

Allocation of Foreign Partner Institution

The MIM programmes offered by both partner institutions are globally recognized and highly ranked. According to the Financial Times 2024 rankings, the MIM programme of emlyon business school holds 8th position globally, while the MIM programme at ESCP Business School is ranked 6th worldwide. Students enrolled in the PGDM-IB programme at MDI Gurgaon will be allocated to one of the two partner institutions; emlyon business school or ESCP Business School, through a randomized selection process.

Studying In Europe

- Students enrolled in this programme will have the opportunity to spend two semesters at their allocated foreign partner institution; emlyon business school, Lyon, France or ESCP Business School, France; both of which offer enriching academic and cultural experiences in the heart of Europe.
- The Lyon campus of emlyon business school is renowned for its innovative teaching methodologies and strong industry linkages, providing students with a globally relevant business curriculum in one of France's most historic cities. Similarly, ESCP Business School operates six urban campuses located in major European cities, actively contributing to the development of a European management culture and offering a unique cross-cultural business education.
- Students attending, either emlyon business school or ESCP Business School are not required to pay tuition fees at the host foreign partner institution, provided they complete their academic requirements within one year. However, students are responsible for covering visa fees, visa assistance charges, social security contributions, travel expenses, daily living costs, lodging and boarding, as well as the cost of books and learning materials.
- Partner institutions will assist students by providing information regarding available accommodation options; however, students are responsible for making final housing arrangements independently.
- Students must have comprehensive health insurance coverage (including medical costs & hospitalization) and personal insurance (covering civil liability, individual accidents, and repatriation) for the entire duration of their academic stay at the allocated partner institution.
- Students enrolled in this programme are strongly advised to possess a valid passport (with at least one year of validity) at the time of departure.

Teaching Pedagogy

Students from MDI Gurgaon are fully integrated into international cohorts at both partner institutions. This collaborative and immersive learning environment promotes cross-cultural understanding, broadens global perspectives, and strengthens the ability to work effectively within diverse, international teams.

Scholarships

MDI Gurgaon provides the following scholarships to support and recognize academic excellence and promote inclusive education:

- **O.P. Jindal Scholarship:** An award of INR 1,50,000 is granted to second-year students based on merit.
- **Merit Scholarships:** Three scholarships of INR 40,000 each are awarded to the top three students (based on CGPA) at the end of the second year.
- **Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Scheme:** Designed to support meritorious students from economically weaker sections (EWS), this scholarship scheme offers a total of 12 scholarships annually. Each scholarship provides a 50% tuition fee waiver for students enrolled in the two-year full-time programmes—PGDM, PGDM-HRM, PGDM-IB, or PGDM-Business Analytics at MDI Gurgaon.

Award of Diploma/ Degree

Upon successful completion of the PGDM-IB programme requirements, the student is awarded a Post Graduate Diploma in Management – International Business (PGDM-IB) by MDI Gurgaon, along with a Master in Management (MIM) degree from either emlyon business school or ESCP Business School, depending on the partner institution attended during the international study component.

Admission Process for PGDM/PGDM-HRM/PGDM-IB & PGDM-Business Analytics (2026-28)

Applicants must have a COMMON ADMISSION TEST (CAT 2025) to be eligible for admission to the PGDM, PGDM-HRM, PGDM-IB, and PGDM-Business Analytics programs of MDI Gurgaon and PGDM program of MDI Murshidabad.

Eligibility Requirements:

- At least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in both class X and XII.
- Bachelor's Degree (Minimum 3 years duration for PGDM, PGDM-HRM & PGDM-Business Analytics (Minimum 4 years duration for PGDM-IB), with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in any discipline from any University recognized by the AICTE/AIU/ Ministry of HRD, Government of India¹.
- Candidates appearing for the final examination for the Bachelor's degree (or equivalent examination) and completing all requirements for obtaining the Bachelor's degree by 30th June, 2026 can also apply to the PGDM, PGDM-HRM & PGDM-Business Analytics programmes, subject to furnishing evidence to that effect latest by 31st October, 2026.
- Applicants to the PGDM-IB programme must possess **a minimum of 1 year (one year) work experience as on 31st January 2026, after completion of a minimum 4 years Bachelor's degree for the programme. The candidates with 3 years' bachelor degree are NOT ELIGIBLE for PGDM-IB Programme.**

¹The basis for computing the percentage obtained by the candidate would be based on the practice followed by the university/ institution/board from where the candidate has obtained the degree/certificate. In case of the candidates being awarded grades/CGPA instead of marks, the equivalence would be based on the equivalence certified by the university/ institution/board from where they have obtained bachelor's degree/certificate. In case the university/ institution /board does not have any scheme for converting CGPA into equivalent marks, the equivalence would be established by MDI by multiplying the obtained CGPA with the factor of 9.5.

Online Application Process

- The combined online application form for MDI Gurgaon (PGDM / PGDM-HRM / PGDM-IB / PGDM-Business Analytics) & MDI Murshidabad (PGDM) shall be available on the MDI website <https://www.mdi.ac.in/> with necessary instructions.
- Online registration will be open from Thursday, 25th September 2025 upto Friday, November 28, 2025, till 17:00 hrs.
- Candidates have to make an online payment of Rs. 3,000 (INR three thousand only) inclusive of 18% GST and can select all the programmes they wish to apply for.
- Candidates applying for both MDI-G and MDI-M have to make an online payment of Rs. 3,590 (INR three thousand five hundred ninety only) inclusive of 18% GST.
- NRI Candidates for MDI Gurgaon & Foreign Nationals/ Gulf Quota/ OCI candidates for MDI Murshidabad will have to make an online payment of Rs. 8,496 (INR eight thousand four hundred ninety-six only) inclusive of 18% GST.

NOTE: There is a single unified application form for all programmes. Applicants need to select all programmes (PGDM/PGDM-HRM/PGDM-IB/PGDM-Business Analytics) they wish to apply for.

Selection Process

Shortlisting of candidates for the WAT-GD-PI process will be done on the basis of the details provided in the application form and their CAT 2025 scores. Shortlisted candidates will be called for Group Discussion, Written Analysis Test, and Personal Interviews between February and April 2026 at a center in one of the following cities: Bengaluru, Gurugram, Kolkata, Hyderabad, and Mumbai. Centers other than Gurugram are tentative. The final selection of the candidates will be based on weightages of CAT-2025 scores, WAT-GD-PI, Behavioral Assessment test, Academic merit, Academic diversity, Work experience, and social diversity etc.

Process for NRI Applicants

NRI applicants may apply on the basis of their valid GMAT scores. Personal Interviews will be conducted for shortlisted candidates in the month of April 2026. Government of India (GOI) rules will be followed related to admission of these categories of candidates. GOI guidelines will be applicable when determining the status of NRI applicants. Candidates have to make an online payment of INR 8,496 (INR eight thousand four hundred ninety-six only) inclusive of 18% GST using Credit/Debit card/Net Banking and select NRI category for filling the online application form.

Note for PGDM-IB candidates

Allocation of Foreign Partner Institution (emlyon business school, Lyon, France or ESCP Business School, France). The MIM programmes offered by both partner institutions are globally recognized and highly ranked. According to the Financial Times 2024 rankings, the MIM programme of emlyon business school holds 8th position globally, while the MIM programme at ESCP Business School is ranked 6th worldwide. Students enrolled in the PGDM-IB programme at MDI Gurgaon will be allocated to one of the two partner institutions; emlyon business school or ESCP Business School, through a randomized selection process.

Studying At Europe

Students enrolled in this programme will have the opportunity to spend two semesters at their allocated foreign partner institution; emlyon business school, Lyon, France or ESCP Business School, France; both of which offer enriching academic and cultural experiences in the heart of Europe.

The Lyon campus of emlyon business school is renowned for its innovative teaching methodologies and strong industry linkages, providing students with a globally relevant business curriculum in one of France's most historic cities. Similarly, ESCP Business School operates six urban campuses located in major European cities, actively contributing to the development of a European management culture and offering a unique cross-cultural business education.

Students attending, either emlyon business school or ESCP Business School are not required to pay tuition fees at the host foreign partner institution, provided they complete their academic requirements within one year. However, students are responsible for covering visa fees, visa assistance charges, social security contributions, travel expenses, daily living costs, lodging and boarding, as well as the cost of books and learning materials. Partner institutions will assist students by providing information regarding available accommodation options; however, students are responsible for making final housing arrangements independently.

Students must have comprehensive health insurance coverage (including medical costs & hospitalization) and personal insurance (covering civil liability, individual accidents, and repatriation) for the entire duration of their academic stay at the allocated partner institution. Students enrolled in this programme are strongly advised to possess a valid passport (with at least one year of validity) at the time of departure.

Note: MDI Gurgaon reserves the right to revise fees & other charges at any time during the Academic Year, with prior notice provided before such changes take effect. Gurgaon uses CAT scores for Indian Candidates for shortlisting the candidates for its programmes. Indian candidates can not apply on the basis of their GMAT score. IIIMs have no role either in the selection process or in conducting the programme.

Please Note: Up to a maximum of 5% over & above the "Approved Intake" per Course shall be available under the tuition fee waiver scheme as per the AICTE guidelines.










CTC Categorisation


