Common Notes on Structure (2025–2026)

- **First Year:** Broad MBA core with introductory healthcare exposure to build management foundation.
- **Second Year:** 60–70% healthcare/hospital-focused (core + electives); emphasis on operations, quality, laws, informatics, and emerging areas like AI/digital health.
- **Electives:** Typically 4–8 total across Sem 3 & 4; modern trends include digital health records, telemedicine basics, sustainability in healthcare, and accreditation standards.
- **Additional Requirements** (common in programs): – Mandatory hospital internship/training – Case studies, hospital visits, simulations, live projects – Tools exposure: HIS software, ERP for hospitals, quality tools (Six Sigma

basics) – Value-added: Workshops on NABH standards, medical ethics, soft skills for healthcare leaders
