

# IIM Calcutta MBAEx 2025-26: 19th Batch Fees Structure

## Programme Fee Overview

The programme fee for the MBAEx 19th batch (academic year 2025-2026) at the Indian Institute of Management Calcutta is Indian Rupees 33,50,000/- (non-refundable) or equivalent US\$ for one year, payable in four instalments. This consolidated fee covers tuition, course material, books, accommodation, economy airfare and certain incidental expenses related to the international immersion programme organized by IIM Calcutta, as per institute norms.

## Detailed Fee Payment Schedule

Second Installment	15 March 2025	10,50,000	Second instalment of programme fee
Security Deposit	Along with Second Installment	60,000	Refundable security deposit, payable by Demand Draft/Pay Order favouring IIM Calcutta
Third Installment	21 July 2025	10,50,000	Third instalment of programme fee
Fourth Installment	24 November 2025	10,50,000	Fourth instalment of programme fee

A separate security deposit of Indian Rupees 60,000/- is payable along with the second instalment by Demand Draft/Pay Order favouring the Indian Institute of Management Calcutta. This amount is refundable upon completion of the programme after adjustment of any outstanding dues, if applicable.

## What the Programme Fee Includes

The total programme fee of Indian Rupees 33,50,000/- includes the following components for the duration of the one-year programme: tuition fees for all courses, cost of prescribed course material and textbooks, on-campus accommodation, economy class airfare, and select incidental expenses related to the international immersion programme organized by IIM Calcutta.

## Expenses Not Covered by Programme Fee

The programme fee does not cover certain recurring and personal expenses. Over and above the programme fees mentioned in the payment schedule, students will have to separately bear charges towards electricity, food/mess, and all other expenses of a personal nature. Any additional costs incurred beyond the scope of the defined programme coverage will be the responsibility of the individual student.
